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Math

We continue to work on our
Number Combinations Unit
(Standards 2.OA.2, 2.OA.3, MA.2.a)

- Students will be able to determine if a group of objects is even or odd by pairing off the objects
- Student will be able to fluently add subtract by using an efficient strategy (such as double +/- 1, making a 10, relating subtraction to addition, using 10 as a landmark, etc.)
