Math

We are beginning our **Place Value Unit**

(Standards 2.NBT.1, 2.NBT.2, 2.NBT.4, 2.NBT.8)

- Students will be able to understand that the digits in a 3-digit number represent the number of hundreds, tens, and ones in the number
- Students will be able to read and write numbers within 1,000 using base-ten numerals, number names, and expanded form
